ORDER

The Minnesota Municipal Commission received a petition for the detachment of land from the City of Owatonna, Minnesota, on the 15th day of March, 1968, by the owners. A resolution for the detachment of the same land was filed by the City of Owatonna.

The territory involved consists of the following:

The West Half of the Northwest Quarter of
the Northeast Quarter of Section 5, Town-
ship 107 North, Range 20 West

The property is adjacent to the City of Owatonna and said lands are unplatted and used exclusively for agricultural purposes. The petition is in proper legal form and sets forth the information required in Minnesota Statutes 414.06 and upon the files and records, the Minnesota Municipal Commission being fully advised in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED: That the foregoing described real property be, and the same hereby is, detached from the City of Owatonna, and made a part of the Township of Owatonna, the same as if it had originally been made a part thereof.
