WHEREAS, the success of this project has depended not only upon the energy and desire of these one-half million young people, but upon the cooperation and concern of businessmen and residents throughout this state, and

WHEREAS, with these young people and their ideals go the hopes and dreams of citizens throughout thin great state,

MOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVender, Governor of the State of Minnasota, do hereby proclaim Friday, March 29, 1968, as

"MINNESOTA TEEN CORPS CIVIC PROJECT DAY"

in Minnesote, and urge that all citizens enthusiastically support its projects and gosts.
