- WHEREAS, the world is becoming more complex, the problems more numerous and difficult to solve, and
- WHEREAS, our future is inextricably tied to that of the Free World and developments of the Communist World, and
- WHEREAS, the National Security Seminar is a broad, information-packed presentation of facts about our national security, and
- WHEREAS, it is hoped that a wide cross-section of civilians from industry, labor, business, the professions, religion, education and women's organization as well as reserve officers of the Army, Navy, Air Force and Marine Corps will take advantage of this great opportunity,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold Lavender, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the weeks of April 1 - 12, 1968, as

"NATIONAL SECURITY SEMINAR WEEKS"

in Minnesota, and urge all its citizens to accept their rights and responsibilities to help meet these challenges of conflict and change by attending the National Security Seminar.
