PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, teachers, in cooperation with the community and the country as a whole, are engaged in shaping a world of discovery and change; and

WHEREAS, education is the basis for determining the future of a free society and for adapting to the complexities of modern life; and

WHEREAS, the importance of education today makes it imperative that our classrooms attract and retain the best possible teachers;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of April, 1968, as

"TEACHING CAREER MONTH"

in Minnesota in order to recognize the responsibilities inherent in the teaching profession, to promote conditions that enhance the quality of education, and to acknowledge the achievements of the teachers of our nation.
