AN ORDINANCE Annexing to the City of Rochester, Minnesota, Certain Unplatted Land Not Exceeding Two Hundred Acres in Area, All Being in the Northwest Quarter of Section Six, Township One Hundred Six North, Range Thirteen West, Olmsted County, Minnesota.
