

MINUTES OF THE GENERAL ELECTION.

AT THE GENERAL ELECTION OF THE VILLAGE OF MOTLEY IN THE COUNTY OF MORRISON AND STATE OF MINNESOTA, HELD AT THE VILLAGE HALL BEING THE PLACE WHERE IT WAS DIRECTED TO BE HELD BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL AFTER GIVING DUE NOTICE THEREOF AS PROVIDED BY LAW; ON THE 11TH DAY OF MARCH A. D. 1919 F. D. NEWKIRK; H. W. ANDRUS AND JOHN WICKLUND THREE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF SAID VILLAGE, TO ACT AS JUDGES OF SUCH GENERAL ELECTION AND ONE QUALIFIED VOTER OF SAID VILLAGE TO ACT AS CLERK OF SUCH GENERAL ELECTION, EACH OF WHOM HAD WITHIN TEN DAYS BEFORE SUCH TIME BEEN DESIGNATED AND APPOINTED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL TO ACT AS JUDGES AND CLERK RESPECTIVELY OF SUCH GENERAL ELECTION----- WHO, BEING PRESENT, AT THE HOUR OF 9 O'CLOCK A. M.; EACH OF THEM DULY TOOK AND SUBSCRIBED AN OATH TO FAITHFULLY DISCHARGE THE DUTIES REQUIRED OF THEM AT SUCH ELECTION, AND THE SAID JUDGE AND CLERK BEING DULY QUALIFIED, FORTHWITH OPENED THE POLLS BY PROCLAMATION, AND THE ELECTION PROCEEDED BY BALLOT WITHOUT ADJOURNMENT OR INTERMISSION UNTIL CLOSED.

THE SUBJECTS VOTED ON AT SUCH GENERAL ELECTION, AS STATED IN THE NOTICE THEREOF, WERE:

SHOULD THE VILLAGE OF MOTLEY BE SEPARATED FROM THE TOWN OF MOTLEY FOR ASSESSMENT AND ELECTION PURPOSES AND BECOME A SEPARATE ELECTION AND ASSESSMENT DISTRICT? YES OR NO.

AT 9 O'CLOCK IN THE FORENOON OF SAID DAY THE POLLS WERE CLOSED PROCLAMATION THEREOF HAVING BEEN MADE BY ONE OF THE JUDGES THERETO. THE JUDGES AND CLERK THEN PROCEEDED FORTHWITH TO PUBLICLY COUNT THE VOTES CAST, AND THE RESULT THEREOF WAS DULY PROCLAIMED TO THE VOTER BY SAID JUDGES AND CLERK, WHO RECORDED THE SAME IN THE VILLAGE MINUTE BOOK.

WE THE UNDERSIGNED, MEMBERS OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MOTLEY, MORRISON COUNTY, MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY CERTIFY TO YOU, IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 1238 G. S. 1917, AS FOLLOWS:

THAT ON THE 11TH OF MARCH 1919 A GENERAL ELECTION WAS DULY HELD IN THE SAID VILLAGE OF MOTLEY, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE SAID VILLAGE, THE FOLLOWING QUESTION: "SHALL THE VILLAGE OF MOTLEY BE SEPARATED FROM THE TOWN OF MOTLEY FOR ASSESSEMENT AND ELECTION PROPOSES AND BECOME A SEPARATE ELECTION AND ASSESSMENT DISTRICT. THAT SAID GENERAL ELECTION WAS DULY CALLED AND HELD, AND THAT THE NUMBERS OF VOTES CAST AT SAID ELECTION ON THE SAID QUESTION WAS 81, AS FOLLOWS: FOR THE SEPARATION AND IN FAVOR THEREOF: 59; AGAINST 22.

THAT THE JUDGES OF THE SAID GENERAL ELECTION HAVE DULY CERTIFIED THE FOREGOING FACTS TO THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE SAID VILLAGE, AS PROVIDED BY STATUTE, AND THAT THE SAID COUNCIL HEREBY CERTIFIES THE RESULT OF THE SAID ELECTION TO YOU, AS PROVIDED BY LAW.
