PROCLAMATION

- WHEREAS, Latin is recognized universally as the language of scholarship and learning, and
- WHEREAS, Americans and all other peoples of the contemporary world recognize the great debt of modern civilization to the contributions of the ancient world of Rome and Greece, in the fields of law, literature, and all of the arts, and
- WHEREAS, It is important that the study of the Classics be encouraged and fostered in the schools of our state, and
- WHEREAS, Any activities that foster appreciation and recognition of the values of Latin are to be commended,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of April 19 - 26, 1968, as

"MINNESOTA LATIN WEEK"

in Minnesota, and call upon all our citizens to join in recognizing the values of such study for the full and complete education of young Americans.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this eighth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-eight, and of the State, the one hundred tenth.
