WHEREAS the prestige of this event gives the Capital City of this State the distinction of being National Youth Oratory Capital for a day,


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Thursday, April 11, 1968, as
