WHEREAS, the membership of the Association is dedicated to elevating the status of all women in business, through appropriate training, the improvement of employer-employee relations, and continuing education, and

WHEREAS, one of the main objectives of this Association is the awarding of scholarships by chapters to qualified and deserving women students, and

WHEREAS, in addition to scholarships from the national educational fund, in the past year ABWA chapter scholarships have amounted to over \$160,000,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the Month of May, 1968, as

"ABWA SCHOLARSHIP MONTH"

in Minnesota, and urge all residents of this state to take proper cognizance thereof.
