PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the Twin Cities Catholic Alumni Club is an organization of single, catholic college graduates with approximately 400 members, and

WHEREAS, the Twin Cities Catholic Alumni Club was founded in Minnesota on the 26th day of April, 1958 as a member of the National Association of Catholic Alumni Clubs, and

WHEREAS, there are some 30 affiliated clubs throughout the United States and Canada with in excess of 15,000 members, and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Club is to promote the religious, educational, social and recreational development of its members and to further and foster public welfare through community service projects, and

WHEREAS, there is a growing need for organizations which will provide the increasing number of young adults of the State of Minnesota with the opportunity to associate and develop with persons of their age and interests,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the 26th day of April, 1968, as

"CATHOLIC ALUMNI DAY"

In Minnesota, and urge every citizen to observe this day by becoming aware of activities of the Twin Cities Catholic Alumni Club and by recognizing the contribution it makes to the State of Minnesota.
