PROCLAMATION.

At least one day of the Spring months should be especially set aside for the purpose of taking steps to prevent destruction by fire and to promote the health of our people.

The losses sustained by conflagrations occasioned by carelessness are so enormous that all must realize the necessity of complying with the requests to remove rubbish and waste and adopt such measures as will tend to eliminate fire hazard.

THEREFORE, I, J.A.A. Burnquist, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby designate

MAY 3, 1919

as

C L E A N - U P D A Y

and direct that the proper State and local officials and school authorities call the attention of our people to the need of activities along the lines herein suggested.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereto caused the Great Seal of the State to be affixed and have hereunto set my hand, at the Capitol in the city of Saint Paul, this nineteenth day of April, 1919.
