PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, on May 11, 1058, the Congressoof the United States passed the bill admitting Winnesote to the Union, and

WHEREAS, this glorious milestone in the life of our State chould serve as a heartfelt inspiration and trustworthy buide for the future as we look back on more than a century of catisfying progress and review the achievements of the distinguished men and women who helped develop the human, spiritual and natural resources of the State.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LaVender, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Saturday, May 11, 1968, as a time for the observance of the

"ONE HUMBRED TENTH ADDITIONARY OF PARTIESOTA"

so that we may rededicate ourselves to the ideals and historic goals of the men and women who have contributed to the progress of the State during the past one hundred years, and I urgs all Minnesotans to fly the State Flag in honor of this occanion.

IN WITHESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this tenth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-eight, and of the State, the one hundred tenth.
