- WHEREAS, the Penny-A-Meal program has been endorsed by the Governor, Commissioner of Education, and other leading people in our state,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of May, 1968, as
