PROCLAMATION


- WHEREAS, women play an increasingly greater part in the insurance industry throughout our nation, and

- WHEREAS, these women deserve commendation and recognition for their outstanding accomplishments in this important field,


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LoVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 19 - 25, 1968, as
