Hilton, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by statute, and particularly by an act of the legislature entitled "An Act to Provide for an Additional Assistant Attorney General", approved April 17, 1919, do hereby constitute and appoint John Everall of St. Paul, Minnesota, to be an Assistant Attorney General of the State of Minnesota for the period commencing April 24, 1919, and ending the first Monday in January, 1921, and until his successor is appointed and qualified, unless sooner revoked.




