WHEREAS, safe student transportation in school buses cannot be overemphasized in view of today's high volume of traffic throughout the State of Minnesota, and

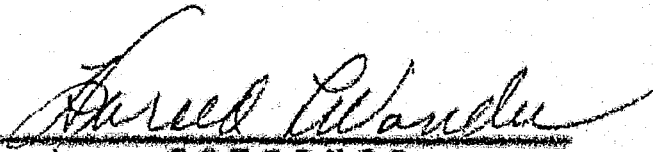

"SCHOOL BUS SAFETY WEEK"

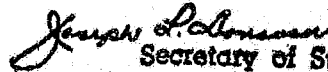

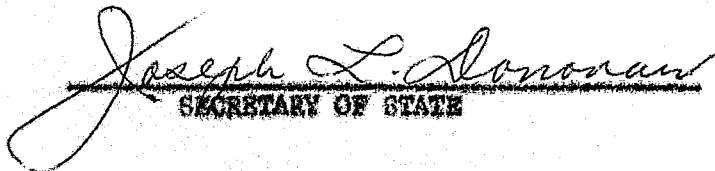
