WHEREAS, our abundant harvests of crops and livestock are being threatened by the presence and escalating spread of the devastating weed pest "Canada Thistle,"


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of June, 1968, as
