
Dear Mr. Swenson:

ORDINANCE NO. 166

ORDINANCE ANNEXING ADJOINING LANDS

The City Council of the City of Madison do ordain:

Section 1: That the following described land adjoining the limits of the City of Madison, located in the County of Lac qui Parle, State of Minnesota, is hereby added to, taken into and made a part of the City of Madison, to-wit:

The West 300 feet of Lot Thirteen (13), Evergreen Addition to Madison, in Section Twenty-one (21), Township One Hundred Eighteen (118), Range Forty-four (44), together with the street dedicated as Park Avenue and road right of way located between the West 300 feet of said Lot 13 and the corporate limits of said city of Madison.

Section 2: That on the taking effect of this ordinance the corporate limits and boundary lines of the City of Madison shall be and are hereby extended to include easterly, southerly and northerly boundaries of the above described tract of land.

Section 3: This ordinance shall be in full force thirty days from and after its passage.
