I, Theodore Oss, Clerk of the Village of Hitterdal in the County of Olay and State of Minnesota, do hereby certify that at the Special Village Election, held in said village on the 28th day of April 1919, at which election the following question, was submitted to the voters, viz:

"Shall the Village of Hitterdal become and constitute a separate election and assessment district as provided by Section 1238, General Statutes of Mønnesota, 1913",
