## CERTIFIED COPY OF RESOLUTION.

The following Resolution was unanimously adopted by the City Commission of the City of St. Cloud, Minnesota, at a duly called Special Meeting of the said City Commission of the City of St. Cloud, held on the 25th day of April, 1919, at two o'clock P. M., all members of the Commission being in attendance, relating to the annexation to the City of St. Cloud, Minnesota, of the real estate and property of Pan Motor Company, a corporation, in said Resolution more fully described, said annexation proceeding being based upon the petition of said Pan Motor Company, owner of said real estate, and pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 159, General Lems of Minnesota of 1919, approved April 2nd, 1919.

Commissioner Magnuson procented the following resolution and moved its adoption, which motion was seconded by Commissioner Maybury:

CHERRAS, Pan Motor Company, a corporation, is the owner of certain real estate, consisting of one tract and percel of land, abutting upon the corporate limits of the City of St. Cloud. Einnesota, and which lands are situated in Stearns County, Minnesota, and are described as follows, to-wit:

All that part of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (UE) SEA) of Section Nine (0), Toynchip One hundred twenty-fow (134), Range Trenty-cight (38), lying north of the right of you of the Great Northern Railway Comments.

right of way of the Great Morthern Railway Company;
Also, that part of the Test Half of the Southeast Guarter
(No SEL) of Section Nine (9), Township One hundred twenty-four
(134), Range Thenty-eight (38), particularly described as follows:
Beginning at a point thirty and five-tenthe (30.5) feet north of the
southeast corner of the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter
(Not SEL) of said Section Nine (9), Township One hundred twenty-four
(134), Range Twenty-eight (38), being the intersection of the
sixteenth section line with the north line of the right of way
of the Great Northern Railway Company; thence Southwesterly, along

parallel with the easterly line of the Northwest Quarter of the

Section Nine (9); thence Southeast Quarter (Not SEE) of said
Section Nine (9), three hundred ninety-six (388) feet, to the
place of beginning;

AND, THEREAS, parament to lest, cald Fan Notor Company has duly propented and filed with the City Commission of the City of St. Cloud, Minnesota, its petition in writing, duly executed and verified, petitioning said City Commission to annex to and bring within the corporate limits of said City of St. Cloud, and subject to city government of said City of St. Cloud, all of the hereinbefore described real estate, and has requested that such action be taken forthwith and without further notice:4

EDT, THTREFORE, Be it Resolved by the City Commission of the City of St. Cloud, Minnesota, that said petition be, and the same hereby is in all things granted, and the above described real catate and property is hereby annexed to and brought within the City of St. Cloud; and is hereby declared to be an addition to said City of St. Cloud, and a part of said City of St. Cloud, as offectually as if said real estate and premises had been originally a part of said City of St. Cloud.

Be it Further Resolved, that a certified copy of this resolution be duly filed and recorded in the effice of the Register of Deeds within and for the County of Stearns and State of Minnesota, the county wherein said territory thus assexed is situated, and that a certified copy of said resolution be also filed in the office of the County Auditor of the County of Stearns and State of Minnesota, as required by the terms of Chapter 150, Session Laws of 1919, of the State of Minnesota, as approved April 2nd, 1919.

Upon the roll being called, the Commissioners who voted in favor of the resolution were: Limperich, Magnuson, Maybury. Those opposed: None. And so the resolution was unanimously adopted, and was so declared by the chair.
