PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS, there are in Minnesota a large number of citizens of Polish descent, with whom all lovers of liberty rejoice because of the independence of Poland as a result of the World War; and

WHEREAS, representatives of people of Polish ancestry have requested that a certain day be set aside in this state for the expression by them of their appreciation of the redemption of Poland from oppressive foreign rule;

THEREFORE, I, Joseph A.A. Burnquist, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby designate

MAY 16, 1919

as a day for the celebration by said people of the resurrection of that freedom which their ancestors enjoyed and the restoration of a great and peace-loving nation which has never fought a war of conquest.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and have hereto caused the Great Seal of the State to be affixed, at the Capitol in the City of Saint Paul, this seventh day of May, 1919.
