ANNEXATION ORDINANCE

An ordinance annexing certain unplatted lands under 200 acres of area to the Village of Grand Rapids and extending the boundaries of said village to include lands described herein and declaring such lands annexed to the village.

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated May 8, 1968, requesting annexation of territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the council on the 8th day of May, 1968, and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petition and bounded as described is twenty (20) acres of unplatted land no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village, or borough, and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by the two (2) owners of said property, and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the town board, the county board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed, and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the village limits at the south boundary thereof;

The council of the Village of Grand Rapids, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. The village council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interest of the village and of the property affected; (2) that the territory described therein abuts upon the village limits and is urban or suburban in character; and (3) that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village, or borough.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the village are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the village as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

(a) South Half of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (S $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty-three (33), Township Fifty-five (55) North of Range Twenty-five (25), West of the Fourth Principal Meridian.

Section 3. Filing. The village clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, and the County Auditor.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3.

Adopted by the Village Council this 19th day of June, 1968.
