ORDINANCE NO. 416

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN PROPERTY ABUTT-ING THE CITY OF ANOKA, TO THE CITY OF ANOKA.

The Commission of the City of Anoka do ordain as follows:

Section 1.

Pursuant to a proper and suf-ficient petition by Anoka-Hen-nepin Independent School Dis-trict No. 11, a municipal cor-poration, the owner of a tract, piece and parcel of land abutt-ing the City of Anoka Minne-sota and described as follows sota, and described as follows, to-wit:

That part of Lot 3, Auditor's Subdivision No. 28, Anoka County, Minnesota, lying Southeasterly of the follow-ing described line: Begining described line: Begin-ning at the Northwesterly corner of said Lot 3, which corner is located on the Southwesterly line of the railroad right-of-way of the Great Northern Railroad and Northern Pacific Rail-way at the intersection of the North and South cen-ter line of Section 35, Town-ship 32, Range 25; thence Southeasterly a long said Southwesterly right-of-way line, said right-of-way line also being the Northerly line of said Lot 3, a distance of 324.04 feet, being meas-ured along said right-of-way line, to the actual point of line, to the actual point of commencement of that par-ticular line to be described; thence Southwesterly de-flecting to the right at an angle of 95 degrees and 50 minutes, from the last de-scribed course in this description, a distance of 521.9 feet to a point in the Northreet to a point in the North-erly line of the right-of-way of State Highway No. 10, said point in said right-of-way line being 43 feet Northerly of, measured at right angles, to the original center line of the Old Mili-

tary Road as the same was ary road as the same was originally laid and con-structed and that particu-lar line being described terminating thereat, said termination point on said Northerly highway right-ofway line, above described, being 50.95 feet Southeast-erly, measured along said Northerly highway right-ofway line, from the North and South center line of Section 35, Township 32, Range 25;

Also, that part of Lot 4, Auditor's Subdivision No. 28, lying Westerly of the following line: Commencing at a point on the North line of Lot 8, said Auditor's Sub-division No. 28, that is 118 feat West of the Northeast feet West of the Northeast corner of said Lot 8, said Northeast corner being the corner as the lot is now laid out and recognized by fenced boundaries; and proceeding thence in a North-easterly direction in a direct line to a point on the Northerly line of said Lot 4, also being the Southerly line of the Great Northern Railroad right of way, said nambau right of way, said point being Southeasterly a distance of 1371.1 feet from the Northwest Corner of Lot 3, Auditor's Subdivision No. 28, measured along the Southealth line of the said Southerly line of the said railroad right of way, said Northwest corner of Government Lot 3, being des-ignated by a permanent monument installed therein prior to September, 1954; Also, another part of Lot 4, Auditor's Subdivision No. 28, described as follows: Commencing at the North-east corner of Lot 8 as lot is now recognized by fenced boundaries, in said Audi-tor's Subdivision; thence West on the North line of said Lot 8 a distance of 118 feet; thence Northeasterly in a direct line 525 feet to a point on the Northerly

line of said Lot 4 and South-erly line of Great North-ern Railroad right of way, said point being Southeast-erly 1371.1 feet measured along Southerly line of said along Southerly line of said railroad right of way from the Northwest corner of Lot 3 in said Auditor's Subdi-3 in Said Auditor's Subdi-vision, said Northwest cor-ner of Lot 3 being desig-nated by permanent monu-ment installed prior to Sep-tember, 1954; thence South-easterly on Northerly line of Lot 4 a distance of 117.9 feet; thence Southwesterly in a direct line 483.1 feet to said Northeast corner of to said Northeast corner of Lot 8 and place of com-mencement;

Also, Lot 8, Auditor's Sub-division No. 28, Anoka County, Minnesota;

to have said territory annexed to the City of Anoka, the Com-mission having determined that the land described in said petition abuts on the City of Ano-ka, is not included in any other municipality, does not exceed 200 acres in area, and that the annexation to the City of Anoka will be to the best interests of the City of Anoka and of the territory described in the peti-tion, said tract, piece and par-cel of land is hereby declared to be annexed to and to be an addition to the City of Anoka.

Section 2.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty (30) days from date of publication.
