WHEREAS, the members of Pickle Packers International are this year conducting a vigorous nonpartisan campaign urging all citizens to vote, and

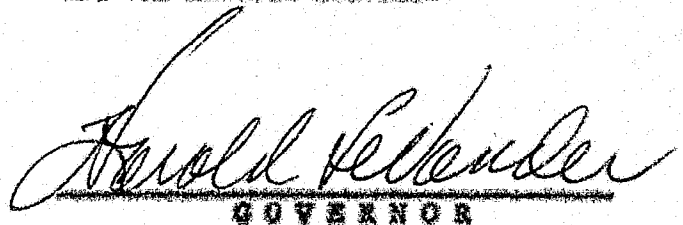
WHEREAS, in this time it is particularly necessary that every man and woman declare that the American system is vigorous and successful by registering a choice of the persons they deem will best represent them,

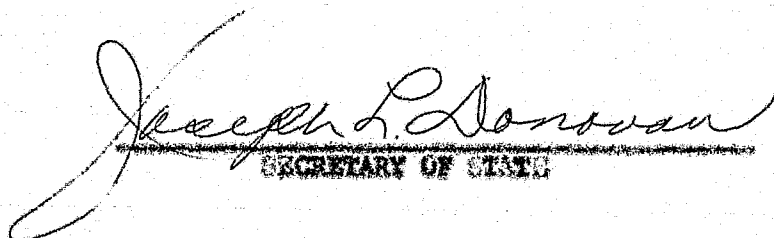
NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 26 - June 1, 1968, as
