PROCLAMATION

- WHEREAS, the American Physical Therapy Association represents over 13,000 qualified physical therapists; and
- WHEREAS, the American Physical Therapy Association will observe its Forty-seventh Anniversary and will hold its Forty-fifth Annual Conference in Chicago during the period June 30 through July 5; and
- WHEREAS, the members of the Minnesota and Southern Minnesota Chapters of the American Physical Therapy Association have assisted with regional planning and the successful conduct of this Conference; and
- WHEREAS, approximately 2,000 physical therapists from all parts of the United States are expected to be in attendance at this Conference; and
- WHEREAS, the scientific and business sessions of this Conference will contribute significantly to the health care of the citizens of Minnesota and to all people in the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the work that physical therapists perform in the interest of all mankind is altogether worthy of official recognition,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the week of June 30 through July 5, 1968 as

"AMERICAN PHYSICAL THERAPY WEEK"

through Minnesota, and request the appropriate consideration be given this designated period.
