

Ordinance No. 41


An Ordinance Annexing certain lots and lands to the Village of  
Walnut Grove, Redwood County, Minnesota.


The Village Council of the Village of Walnut Grove, Redwood County,  
Minnesota, do ordain as follows:---

Section 1. That the following described land and all thereof,  
to-wit: Auditor's Subdivision No. One (1) of the South-East Quarter of  
the North-East Quarter of Section Twenty-Five (25), Township One Hundred Nine  
(109), North, of Range Thirty-nine (39), West, the total acreage of said  
Subdivision being forty (40) acres, and including all of the lots and lands  
within said South-East Quarter of said North-East Quarter of said land, Section  
25, Township 109, Range 39, said Subdivision and each and every lot, piece  
and parcel of said forty acre tract, being adjacent to and abutting upon the  
said incorporated Village of Walnut Grove, Redwood County, Minnesota, be, and  
the same hereby are, annexed to and included in said incorporated Village of  
Walnut Grove and the boundaries of the said Village of Walnut Grove, Redwood  
County, Minnesota, are hereby extended so as to include within said Village  
the hereinbefore mentioned forty acre tract.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force  
from and after its Publication.
