PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS,

the Fourteenth Annual Minnesota All Arabian Horse Show will be held June 22nd and 23rd when the members of the aforementioned show will endeavor to present to the State of Minnesota a program of equine ability of nationwide prominence as one of the largest Arabian Horse Shows in the world, and

WHEREAS,

during the course of the show the spectator will have the opportunity to see the world's most beautiful and most versatile horse perform in all phases of English and Western equipment and the colorful Arabian costume for which he is noted, and

WHEREAS,

the natural beauty and presence of the Arabian coupled with its classic, functional characteristics, will be greatly in evidence in the many breeding classes, and

WHEREAS,

the period of June 22 and 23, 1968, has been set aside as the First Annual Celebration for the Arabian Horse.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold Lavander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim June 22 and 23, 1968, as

"MINNESOTA ARABIAN HORSE DAYS"

and do heartily command to all our citizens a full participation in all the events related thereto.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREON, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twentieth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-eight, and of the State, the one hundred eleventh.
