

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the 59th Annual Meeting of the American Home Economics Association is being convened in Minneapolis from June 24 to 28, 1968, and

WHEREAS, home economics is the field of knowledge and service primarily concerned with meeting the needs of homes and families through: Educating the individual for family living; Improving the goods and services used by families; Conducting research to discover changing needs of individuals and families and means of satisfying these needs; and Furthering community, national, and world conditions favorable to family living, and


WHEREAS, home economists working in Minnesota are and have made through the years important contributions to both rural and urban families in their work in teaching, business, the extension service, institution administration, community services, and their participation in various international service programs,

NOW THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week June 23 to 29 as

"MINNESOTA HOME ECONOMICS WEEK"

through Minnesota, and request the appropriate consideration be given this designated period.
