- WHEREAS, the annual Minnesota State Junior Track Meet, hosted by the Minneapolis Jaycees, will be held at the University of Minnesota on June 29th, 1968, and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold Levander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Saturday, June 29, 1968, as
