

PROCLAMATION

- WHEREAS, October 11, 1968, has been set aside as a special day of tribute to the public schools of the State of Minnesota; and
- WHEREAS, the Hibbing High School, which is typical and a representative school of our North Star State, has been awarded the twenty-seventh annual Bellamy Flag Award which recognizes Francis Bellamy, author of the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America, and the free public schools in this Nation; and
- WHEREAS, the Hibbing High School has been designated to hold the special honor for a fifty-year period in the group of outstanding and representative Bellamy Award Schools throughout the Nation; and
- WHEREAS, the Bellamy Advisory Board has judged the representative Hibbing High School as one with these 10 characteristics contributing to its choice: "the proficient performance of duty by the administrators, a dedicated and professional staff that works to secure top level education for all its youth, the Student Council's Safety Drive Program, Hibbing's program for the blind, the educational philosophy of the Hibbing High School, the accomplishments of the alumni, maintaining consistent high standards of education, a strong program of patriotic and good citizenship training, direct contact of parents with the high school, and the school-press relationship,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Friday, October 11, 1968, as

"FRANCIS BELLAMY FLAG AWARD DAY"
