
WHEREAS, the cat is a treasured pet of children and adults alike; and

abroad;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do
hereby proclaim the week of November 3-9, 1968, as


"CAT WEEK INTERNATIONAL"
