## COMPANY TO LOS

AN CEDIMANCE EXTENDED THE OCCIPANCE LINIES OF THE CITY OF VENTURATOR, ELEMESTIA, TO INCLUDE CENTAIN PLATTED AND UNPLATTED SAMES.

The City Council of the City of Morthington Do Ordein:

Section 1. The territory hereinefter described, is now camed by the City of Vorthington; and whoreas said property is situated catalde of, but contiguous to, and abutting on the corporate limits of the City, the City Council of said City of Vorthington has determined to have such land included within the City of Vorthington, Himpesota:

Lot One (1), County Auditor's Pict of Duss Outlots (Duss Field)

ouls

County Aid Road No. 7 right-of-way 66 feet in width shutting the westerly boundary of County Anditor's Flat of Dues Outlooks, and extending from the southeasterly right-of-way line of the Chicago and North Western Railway Company South to a point 75 feet North of the center line of State Highways No. 59 and 60.

Section 2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing descriptions, and bounded as described is 17.97 acres.

Section 3. Notice was duly given the Board of Commissioners for Nobles County and the Board of Commissioners for Vorthington Township on June 17, 1968, that said matter was being considered by the City Council of the City of Worthington and a hearing was held by the City Council of the City of Vorthington, on the proposed summation after publication of notice of hearing as required by City Charter.

Section 4. The City Council hereby determines (1) that the apparation will be to the best interests of the City of Worthington, Misnesots, and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described hereis claim upon the City and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to city government.

Section 5. The comporate limits of the City are herety extended to include the property described in Section 1, and the same is hereby assessed to, and included in the City as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 6. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Mirresote Familipal Cossission, the County inditor and the Secretary of State.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication and upon the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 6.
