ORDINANCE NO. 426

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WORTHINGTON, MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN PLATTED AND UNPLATTED LANDS.

The City Council of the City of Worthington Do Ordain:

Section 1. The territory hereinafter described, is now owned by the City of Worthington, and whereas said property is situated outside of, but contiguous to, and abutting on the corporate limits of the City, the City Council of said City of Worthington has determined to have such land included within the City of Worthington, Minnesota:

Lot One (1), County Auditor's Plat of Duss Outlots (Duss Field)

also

County Aid Road No. 7 right-of-way 66 feet in width abutting the westerly boundary of County Auditor's Plat of Duss Outlots, and extending from the southeasterly right-of-way line of the Chicago and North Western Railway Company South to a point 75 feet North of the center line of State Highways No. 59 and 60.

Section 2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing descriptions, and bounded as described is 17.97 acres.

Section 3. Notice was duly given the Board of Commissioners for Nobles County and the Board of Commissioners for Worthington Township on June 17, 1968, that said matter was being considered by the City Council of the City of Worthington and a hearing was held by the City Council of the City of Worthington, on the proposed annexation after publication of notice of hearing as required by City Charter.

Section 4. The City Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the City of Worthington, Minnesota, and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the City and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to city government.

Section 5. The corporate limits of the City are hereby extended to include the property described in Section 1, and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in the City as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 6. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication and upon the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 6.
