ORDINANCE 486
An Ordinance Annexing Certain Lands To The City of Willmar Containing Less Than 200 Acres.

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the governing body of the City of Willmar, a Municipal corporation of the State of Minnesota, by the sole owners thereof, to have certain real property, hereinafter described, included within the City of Willmar, Minnesota, and

WHEREAS, it is proposed to annex by virtue hereof, to the said City of Willmar, said property, all of which is in Kandiyohi County in the said State, and

WHEREAS, said property is described as follows:

The West 230 feet of the East 710 feet of the North 175 feet of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 22, Township 119, Range 35, of said Kandiyohi County.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Willmar hereby determines, deigns, declares, and ordains as follows:

Section 1. Best interest of territory affected. That the annexation will be in the best interest of the City of Willmar, Minnesota, and of the territory affected.

Section 2 Subject to City Government. That the property above described abuts upon the City and is so conditioned as property to be subject to City government.

Section 3. Annexation. That the said property is hereby annexed to, and included within the City of Willmar, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part hereof.

Section 4. Zoning. That the said property shall be zoned BC, Business Commercial.

Section 5. Effective date. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after filing a certified copy hereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor of the County of Kandiyohi and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, and from and after its passage and publication.


