

We, the undersigned, being twenty-five or more legal voters actually residing upon the land within that certain district and territory hereinafter described, to the end that the same may be incorporated as a village, do hereby petition your honorable board to approve and to grant this application and we do hereby request that you appoint a time and place when and where the electors, actually residing within the district and territory hereinbefore described, may vote for or against the incorporation, under the law of the State of Minnesota, of a village to be named Ihlin.

And your petitioners further allege:

That the tract of land, district and territory above referred to and to be included within said proposed village is described as follows:

All of that land and territory in the County of Pipestone, and state of Minnesota described by and lying within metes and bounds as follows, to-wit: Beginning at a point on the section line 20 rods South of the corner stake of sections 9, 10, 15 and 16, all in Township 106, Range 46, said County; thence East, parallel with the North line of said section 15, 100 rods; thence North, parallel to the West lines of said Sections 15 and 10, 300 rods; thence West, parallel with the South lines of said sections 10 and 9, 300 rods; thence South, parallel with the East lines of said sections 9 and 16, 300 rods; thence East, parallel with the North line of said section 10, 100 rods to place of beginning.

That the tract of land, district and territory above referred to and to be included within said proposed village is described as follows:
