PROCLAMATION

The President of the United States has, by proclamation, designated "the period beginning Sunday, June eighth to Flag Day, June fourteenth, as Boy Scout Week."

The splendid work of the Boy Scouts of America, during the war and prior thereto, is so well known and the need of extending the Boy Scout movement so as to give training to a larger number of our boys is so apparent that all of our citizens should be pleased to assist in bringing about such additional opportunities for the proper development of America's youth as will be afforded by the realization of the proposed Boy Scout program.

THEREFORE, I, Joseph A.A. Burnquist, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby urge that as many Minnesota citizens as possible do their share in advancing this movement through the giving of financial assistance and by volunteering their personal services in this patriotic organization.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereto caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed and have hereunto set my hand at the Capitol, in the City of Saint Paul, this fourth day of June, 1919.
