ORDINANCE # 19.06

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPCRATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF BUFFALO TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES.

Section 1. A Petition having been filed with the Governing body
of the Village of Buffalo, Minnesota by all of the owners in
number of the following described real estate to have such land
included within the Village of Buffalo, Minnesota:
That part of the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of
Section 19, Township 120, Range 25 lying West of the centerline
of Minnesota State Highway No. 25, and lying South of the following described line: Beginning at a point on the quarter section
