ORDINANCE # 19.07

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF BUFFALO TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES.

Section 1. A Petition having been filed with the Governing body of the Village of Buffalo, Minnesota by all of the owners 1 in number of the following described real estate to have such land included within the Village of Buffelo, Minnesota:

The East Half of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter and the West 4 acres of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter, Section 29, Township 120, Range 25, Wright County, Minnesota. Containing 24 acres more or less. and also

That part of the SWA of Section 29, Township 120, Range 25, 15 Wright County, Minnesota lying West and North of the following described line: Commencing at the Northeast corner of said SW2; thence West along the North line thereof (having an assumed bearing 18 of West) a distance of 697.89 feet to the actual point of beginning; thence South a distance of 470.24 feet; thence West a 19 distance of 386.35 feet; thence S-64 degrees-57'-46"-W to the 20 West line of said SW2 and terminating thereat.
