



I do hereby recognize him as such, and declare him free to exercise, and enjoy, such
functions, powers, and privileges, as are allowed to the Consuls General of
the most favored Nations in the United States.

United States to be hereunto affixed.

Done at the City of Washington, this nineteenth day of March
in the year of our Lord, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-eight, and of the
Independence of the United States of America, the one hundred and ninety-second.


