

ORDINANCE NO. 63.

An Ordinance Annexing Certain Unplatted Lands to the  
Village of Atwater, Minnesota.

The Village Council of the Village of Atwater do ordain as follows: Section 1.- That the following described un platted lands, to-wit:

That part of the South West Quarter(SW<sup>1</sup>) of the South West Quarter(SW<sup>1</sup>) of Section One(1) in Township One Hundred and Nineteen (119) of Range Thirty-three(33), and described by notes and bounds, as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point 796 ft. North of the South West Corner of Section One(1) in Township One Hundred and Nineteen(119) of Range Thirty-three(33) on the West Boundary line of said Section One(1), running thence East 393 ft. on a line parallel with the South boundary line of said Section One(1), thence North about 524 ft. on a line parallel, with the West Boundary line of said Section One(1) to the subdivision line between the South West Quarter(SW<sup>1</sup>) of the South west Quarter(SW<sup>1</sup>) and the North West Quarter(NW<sup>1</sup>) of the South West Quarter(SW<sup>1</sup>) of said Section One(1), thence West on said subdivision line parallel with the South Boundary line 393 ft. to the West Boundary line of said Section One(1), thence South about 524 ft., to the place of beginning, containing Eight and Fifty-three hundredths (8-53/100) Acres, more or less; and situate in the County of Kandiyohi and State of Minnesota, adjacent to and abutting upon the incorporated Village of Atwater, Kandiyohi County, Minnesota, and containing less than, and not exceeding Two Hundred Acres, be and the same hereby are annexed to such Village as effectually as if they had been originally a part thereof.

Section 2.- That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication and the filing of a certified copy thereof with the Secretary of State.
