
KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, DOUGLAS M. HEAD, Secretary of State

Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of authority vested in me by statute, have constituted and appointed

RICHARD PEMBERTON


of Fergus Falls, Minnesota, as Special Counsel to defend Frank Roberts and Donald Mealey, agents employed by the State Liquor Control Department, in the criminal action commenced against them in the Perham, Minnesota Municipal Court, arising out of acts performed in the regular course of duty. He shall be compensated on a reasonable fee basis, which shall include all clerical and other necessary office expenses incurred by counsel, together with necessary travel expenses; and such compensation shall be payable from the funds of the Liquor Control Commission or from funds appropriated for this purpose upon the recommendation of the Legislative Claims Commission, or, if no such funds are available, from the Special Contingent Fund of the Attorney General. This appointment shall be effective August 20, 1968. Said Special Counsel shall serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General until this matter hereinbefore mentioned is completed.
