

ORDINANCE NO. 377

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MARSHALL TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING TWO HUNDRED ACRES.

The Common Council of the City of Marshall do ordain as follows:

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the Common Council of the City of Marshall, Minnesota by the sole owner of the following described real estate in the County of Lyon, State of Minnesota, to have such land included within the City of Marshall, Minnesota:

Beginning at a point in the east line of Section 8 in Township 111 North, of Range 41, West, which is 55 rods south from the northeast corner of said Section 8, and running thence west parallel with the north line of said Section 8 a distance of 18 rods; thence north parallel with the east line of said Section 8 a distance of 15  $\frac{5}{9}$  rods; thence west parallel with the north line of said Section 8 to the center of the Redwood River; thence up said river channel to a point 40 rods south from the north line of said Section 8; thence west parallel with the north line of said Section 8 to the center of the Redwood River; thence up the channel of said Redwood River to a point 80 rods south from the north line of said Section 8; thence east along said 80-rod line to the east line of said Section 8, and thence north along said east Section line to the place of beginning, subject to the easements in the highways now existing.

South Half of the Northeast Quarter ( $S\frac{1}{2}NE\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 8, Township 111, North, of Range 41, West, except those parts already within the corporate limits of the City of Marshall.

Section 2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description, and bounded and described, is 47 acres, more or less.

Section 3. The Common Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the City of Marshall, Minnesota and of the territory affected; and (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the City and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to city government.

Section 4. Therefore, the City of Marshall, Minnesota hereby ordains and declares that the property hereinbefore described be and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in, the City of Marshall, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in force from and after filing certified copy thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State, and from and after its passage and publication.
