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ORDINANCE No. 1463
AN ORDINANCE Annexing to the City of Rochester, Minnesota, Certain Unplaited Land Not Exceeding Two Hundred Acres in Area. All being in Sections Twenty-One and Twenty-Eight, Township One Hundred Seven, Range Fourteen, West, Oimsted County, Minnesota. The Common Council of the City of Rochester do ordains.

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the Common Council of the City of Rochester, Signed by all of the owners of the land described herein, requesting the Common Council to annex said land to the City of Rochester, The land described in said petition for annexation is located in Cascade Township, Olmsted County, Minnesota, and is described as follows:

All that part of the East half of the Northwest Quarter (NWW) of Section Twenty Eight (28), Township One Hundred Seven (107) North, Range Fourteen (14) West lying south and west of the easterly right-of-way of the Chicago Great Western Railway Company extending from the South line of the Southwest Quarter (SWW) of Section Twenty-One (21), Township One Hundred Seven (107) North, Range Fourteen (14) West to a line at right angles to the railroad centerline and 500 feet northerly, measured along said centerline, from its intersection with the South line of said Section Twenty-One (21). Township One Hundred Seven (107) North, Range Fourteen (14) West, Iving Mortheast of the Right-of-way of the Chicago Great Western Railway Company, except:

(a) A parcel three of described by metes and bounds as follows: commencing at a point 32 rods North of the Southeast Corner of the Above described land, running thence West 12 rods, thence South 16 Rods to the place of beginning.

(b) Also excepting that part of said Quarter Quarter Section Which lies West of a line at right which lies West of a line at right which lies West of a line at right

thence West 12 rods, mence avoring the Rods, thence South 16 Rods to the place of beginning.

(b) Also excepting that part of said Quarter Quarter Section which lies West of a line at right angles to the North line of said Quarter Quarter and distant 138.7 feet East of the North line of said Quarter Quarter and distant 138.7 feet East of the Northwest corner of said Southeast Quarter (SEVA) of the Southwest Quarter (SEVA) of the Southwest Quarter (SEVA) of Section Twenty-One (21).

Said petition has also been filed with the Town Board of the Township of Cascade, with the County Board of the County of Olmsted and with the Municipal Commission of the State of Minnesota. The Town Board of the County Board of the County Of Olmsted have notified the City that they have no objections to the annexation of the above described land.

Section 2. The quantity of unplatted land included in said petition is approximately 103.4 acres.

Section 3. The Common Council of the City of Rochester does hereby determine that the land described in Section 1 abuse upon the present territorial limits of the City of Rochester, its occonditioned as to be properly subjected to Municipal Government, and the annexation of said land will be in the best interests of the City of Rochester and of the land affected.

Section 4. Therefore, the land described in Section 5. Present and tuture owners of the area annexed by this ordinance are hereby notified that in addition to the usual assessments, it is the intention of the Common Council to assess against benefited property all or portion of the cost of any storm sewer, water tower and trunk line sanitary sewer construction, herefore or hereafter, undertaken to serve the area annexed.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its official publication and from and after the filling of a certified copy hereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor and the Secretary of Stafe.
