WHEREAS, the welfare of our citizens and the strength, vitality and progress of our Nation are dependent upon the health of our economy; and

WHEREAS, the principle of freedom of enterprise is the basis of our economy and provides the chief impetus for its growth and stability; and

WHEREAS, a better understanding of freedom of enterprise by the people of Minnesota will preserve and strengthen our free economy

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of August 25 through August 31, 1968, as

"FREEDOM OF ENTERPRISE WEEK"

in Minnesota, and I urge our citizens to acquaint themselves with the principles of freedom of enterprise, and to avail themselves of the special opportunities provided during this observance by Kiwanis Clubs in their respective communities.
