PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, On June 15th, 1919, in the Town of Colvin, St. Louis County, Minnesota, one Jacob Carlson, a citizen of said town, was wantonly murdered, and the officials of said county state they have reason to believe that said murder was committed by William Kumpulu and Mike Maki; and

WHEREAS, said murder was committed under such conditions and circumstances that public welfare demands that the persons responsible therefor be apprehended and punished;

Now, Therefore, I, J. A. A. Burnquist, Governor of the State of Minnesota, will cause to be paid out of the Treasury of the State of Minnesota, the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), for the arrest and conviction, or for information leading to the arrest and conviction of either, of the said William Kumpulu and Mike Maki, or whoever may be responsible for the murder of the said Jacob Carlson, and the sum of One Thousand Dollars, (\$1000.00), for the arrest and conviction of both persons responsible for said murder.
