PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS, on Sunday, June 22, 1919, the City of Fergus Falls and vicinity suffered one of the most horrible calamities in the history of our State, a tornado passing through the aforesaid community on said date, leaving a trail of approximately two hundred (200) dead and injured; and

WHEREAS, hundreds of our fellow citizens were made homeless and a property loss estimated at several million dollars was sustained;

NOW, THEREFORE, an urgent appeal is hereby made to the people of Minnesota to contribute as generously as possible to a fund for assisting the stricken families and aid in the reconstruction of the section destroyed.

The following residents of Fergus Falls, together with Mayor George Frankferg, are hereby appointed a committee to receive and dispurse the money so contributed:— Elmer E. Adams, A. G. Anderson, S. J. Evans, C. R. Wright, and F. E. Hodgson.
