

ORDINANCE NO. 6


AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE ANNUAL ELECTION IN THE VILLAGE OF COOLEY, ITASCA COUNTY, MINNESOTA, TO THE FIRST TUESDAY AFTER THE FIRST MONDAY IN THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER IN EACH YEAR HERE-AFTER.

The Village Council of the Village of Cooley do ordain as follows:

Section 1. The Village Council of the Village of Cooley, Itasca County Minnesota, pursuant to the authority granted it under the provisions of Section 205.07, Subdivision One (1) of the Minnesota Statutes of 1967 elect to hold the general Village elections in the Village of Cooley on the First Tuesday after the First Monday in the Month of November in each year hereafter.


Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.



AFFIDAVIT OF PUBLICATION

STATE OF MINNESOTA, } ss.

Alice Anderson, being duly sworn, on oath says she is and during all the times herein stated has been the publisher of the newspaper known as The Eastern Itasca and has full knowledge of the facts herein stated as follows: (1) Said newspaper is printed in the English language in newspaper format and in column and sheet form equivalent in printed space to at least 900 square inches. (2) Said newspaper is a weekly and is distributed at least once each week. (3) Said newspaper has 50% of its news columns devoted to news of local interest to the community which it purports to serve and does not wholly duplicate any other publication and is not made entirely of patents, plate matter and advertisements. (4) Said newspaper is circulated in and near the municipality which it purports to serve, has at least 500 copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers, has an average of at least 75% of its total circulation currently paid or no more than three months in arrears and has entry as second-class matter in its local post-office. (5) Said newspaper purports to serve the communities of East Itasca County and it has its known office of issue in the Village of Nashwauk in Itasca County, established and open during its regular business hours for the gathering of news, sale of advertisements and sale of subscriptions and maintained by Alice R. and Richard Anderson subject to their direction and control during all such regular business hours and at which said newspaper is printed. (6) Said newspaper files a copy of each issue immediately with the State Historical Society. (7) Said newspaper has complied with all the foregoing conditions for at least two years preceding the day or dates of publication mentioned below. (8) Said newspaper has filed with the Secretary of State of Minnesota prior to January 1, 1966 and each January 1 thereafter an affidavit in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State and signed by the publisher of said newspaper and sworn to before a notary public stating that the newspaper is a legal newspaper.
