WHEREAS, Christopher Columbus Day has officially been established as a legal holiday by enactment of Minnesota Statute 645.44 by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS, the Eveleth Italian-American Club is sponsoring the 44th annual State Columbus Day Celebration at Eveleth on October 12th, 1968, to perpetuate the memory of the legendary Italian explorer who for centuries has been credited with the discovery of America in 1492

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim, Saturday October 12, 1968 as
