- WEREAS, Leif Erikson made the original discovery by non-native Americans of the North American continent in about the year A.D. 1000, and subsequently explored portions thereof, and
- WEREAS, proof of the historical fact rests solidly, not only on independent accounts in the Norse sages, evidence from the archives of European and American libraries, and writings of numerous historians, but also recent scientific findings, and
- WHEREAS, the President of the United States, in due recognition of this historic and intrepld exploit in early American history, has designated October 8 in each year as Leif Erikson Day, and
- WHEREAS, it is particularly appropriate that the State of Minnesota where so many of the residents are of Norwegian birth or background, having contirubæed to the industrial, cultural and governmental life and development of our State, should pay tribute to the memory of Leif Erikson,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Covernor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim October 9, 1968, as

"LEIF ENIKSON DAY"

in Minnesote.
