PROCLAMATION.

The great work done by the Salvation Army in times of peace is universally recognized and on all sides are heard most favorable reports of the courage and patriotism displayed by this organization on the battle-fields of Europe and of the heroism shown by its workers in sharing with the men the many hardships at the front.

To enable the men and women of the Salvation Army to continue their splendid services, it is now proposed to raise Six Hundred Thousand Dollars in the State of Minnesota during the week of August tenth to eighteenth.

NOW THEREFORE, I, J.A.A. Burnquist, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby designate Sunday, the tenth day of August, 1919, as a day to be set aside in memory of the brave and unselfish members of this organization, who did so much for civilization during the World War and request that from all pulpits of our state attention be called to the necessity for the raising of the funds aforesaid and that all of our citizens be prepared to contribute liberally during the said week to this most worthy cause.
